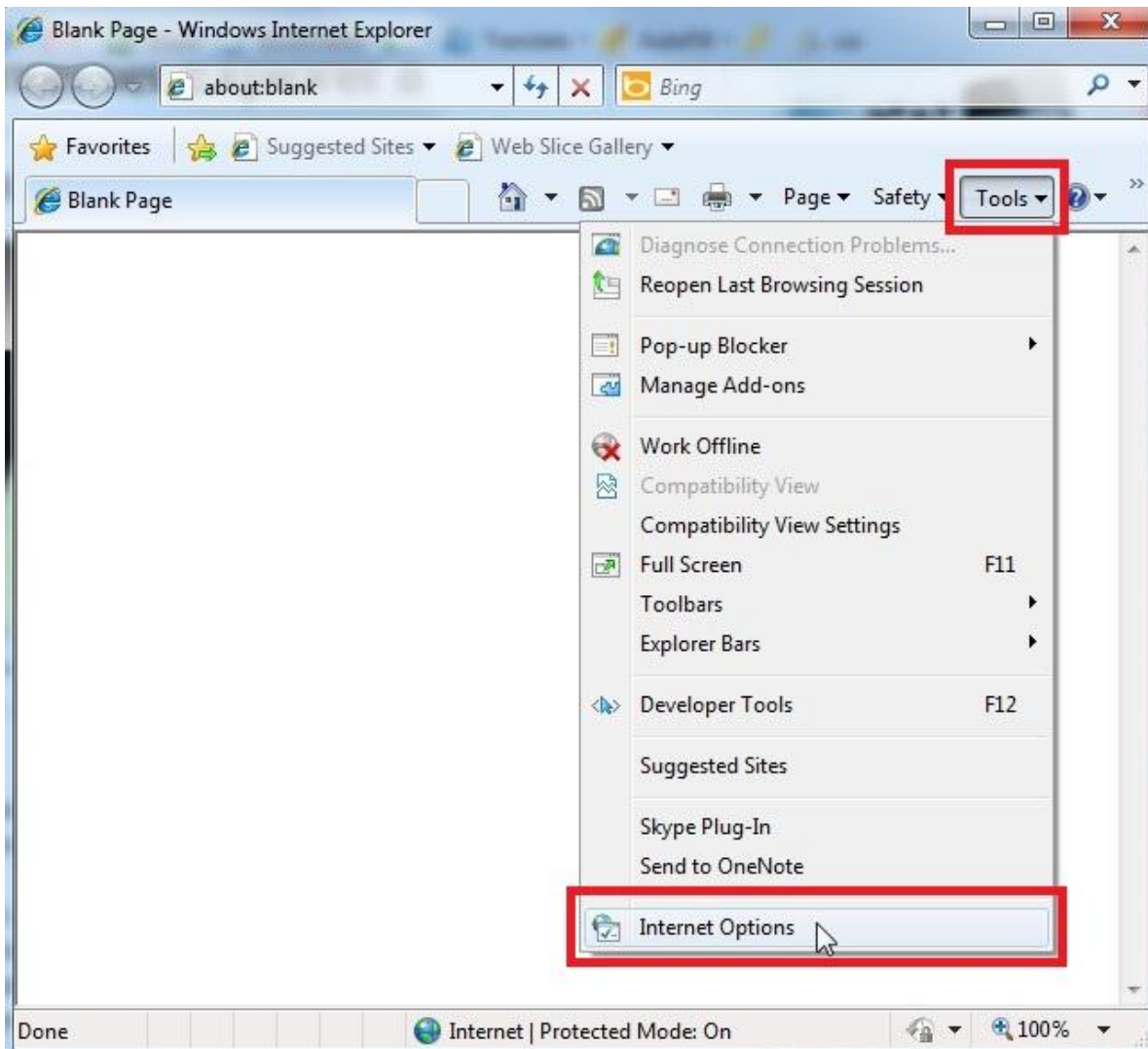


Delete Temporary Files on Internet Explorer 8/9

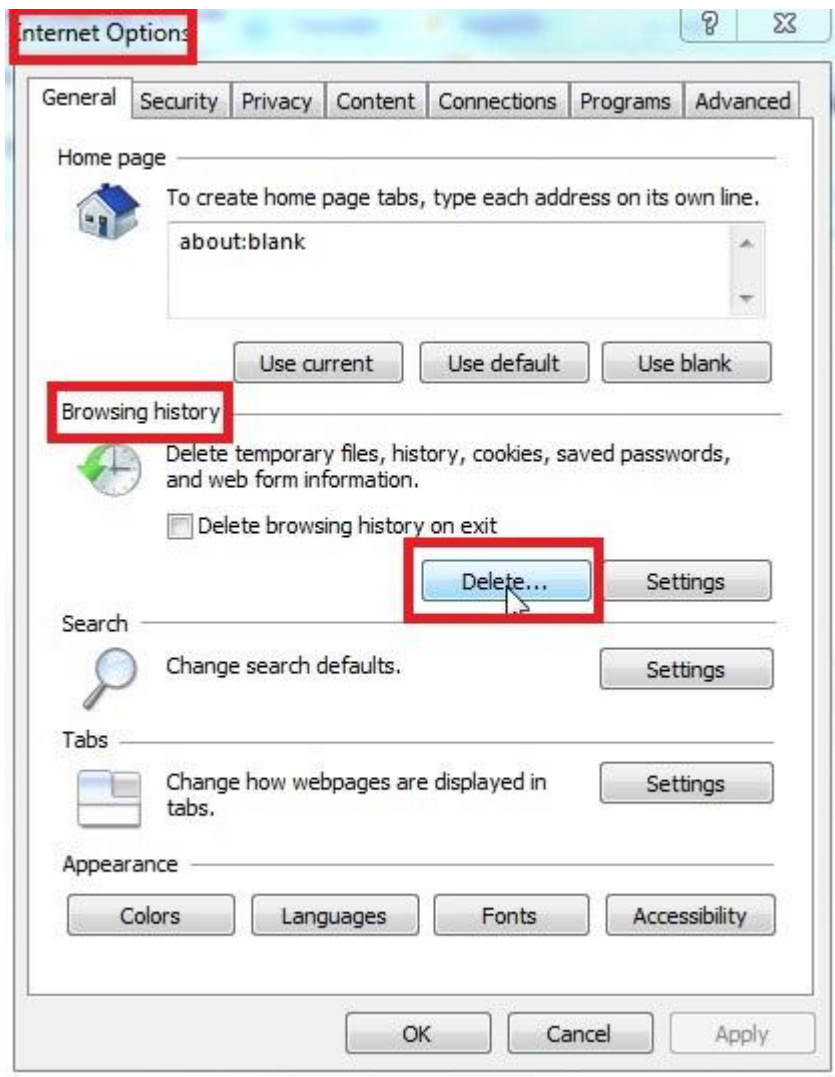
1. Open **Internet Explorer**.



2. Press **Alt + T** then click **Internet Options** or click **Tools => Internet Options**.

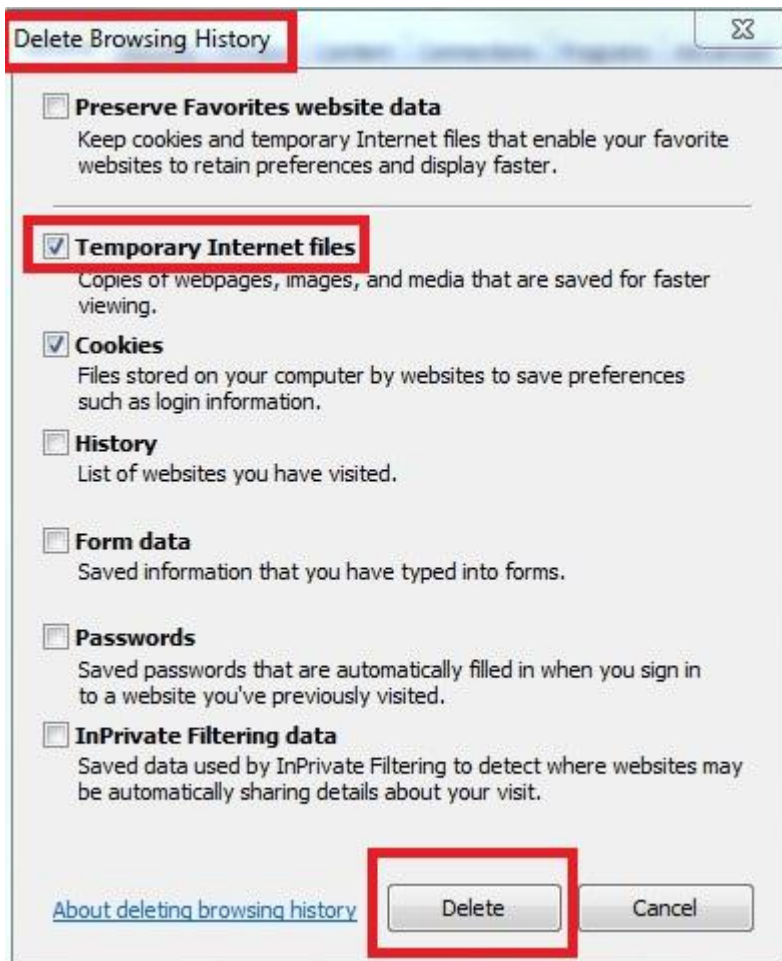
Clear Cach Internet Explorer Tools Options

3. On **Internet Options** box, click **Delete...** button on **Browsing history** section

4. On **Delete Browsing History** box, make sure the **Temporary Internet files** is checked and click **Delete** button.



Clear Cach Internet Explorer Delete Temporary Internet Files

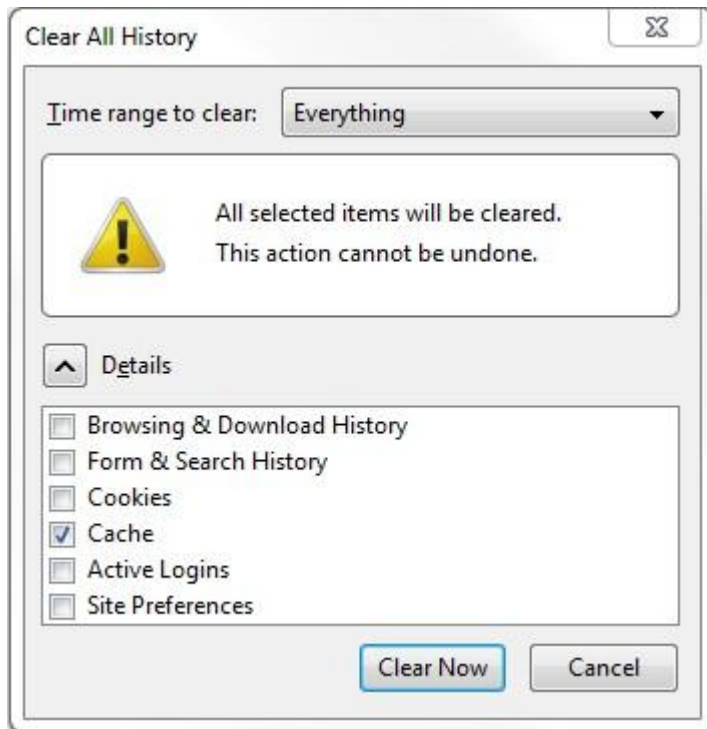
Bonus: this section also be applied if you want to delete:

- **Passwords**
- **InPrivate Filtering data**

Clear Cache On Firefox 4/5..

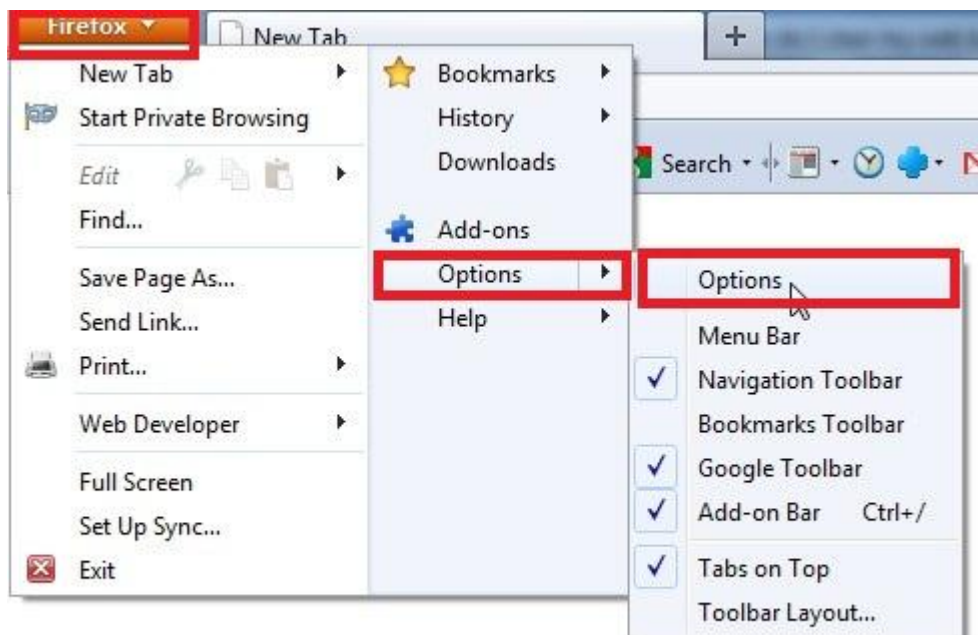
Press the combination buttons: **Ctrl + Shift + Delete** to show the **Clear All History** box. Make sure the **Cache** is checked then click **Clear Now** button. **Note:** you can change the time range to clear by selecting the drop down list on the top.



Clear Cache Firefox

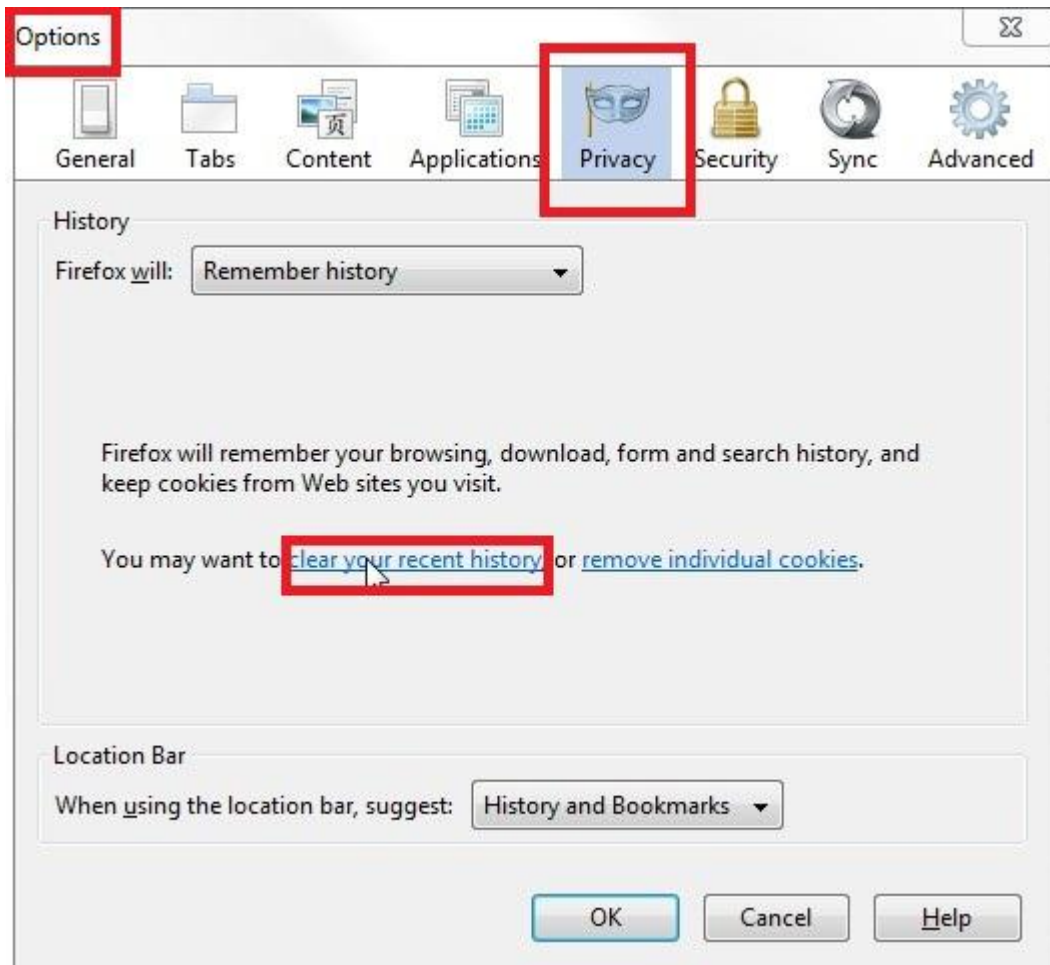
–Or –

1. Click on **Firefox** on the top-left => **Options** => **Options**



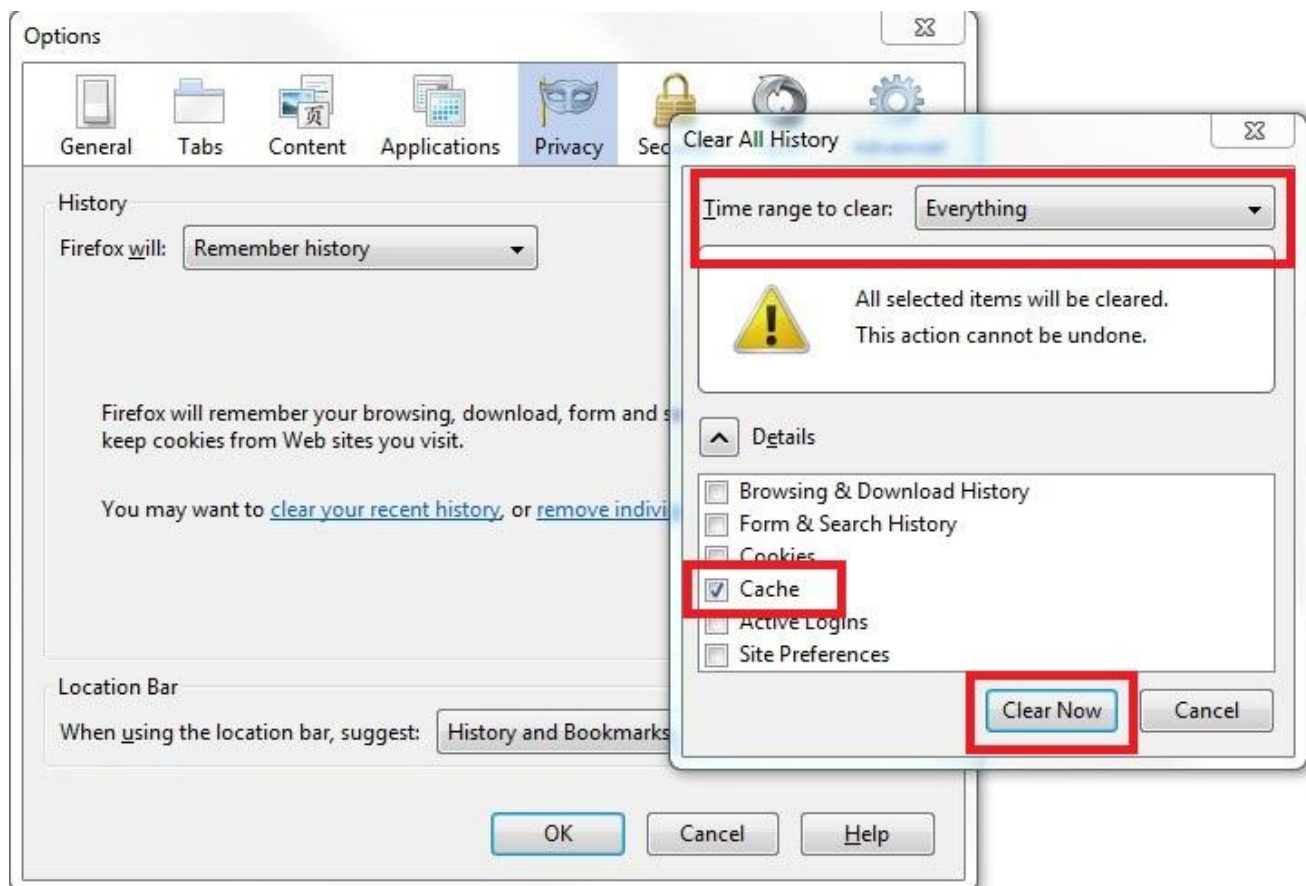
Clear Cache Firefox Options

2. On the **Options** box, click on **Privacy** tab then click on **clear your recent history** link

3. Click on **Cache** then click on **Clear Now** button, same as the previous way.

Bonus: this section also be applied if you want to delete:

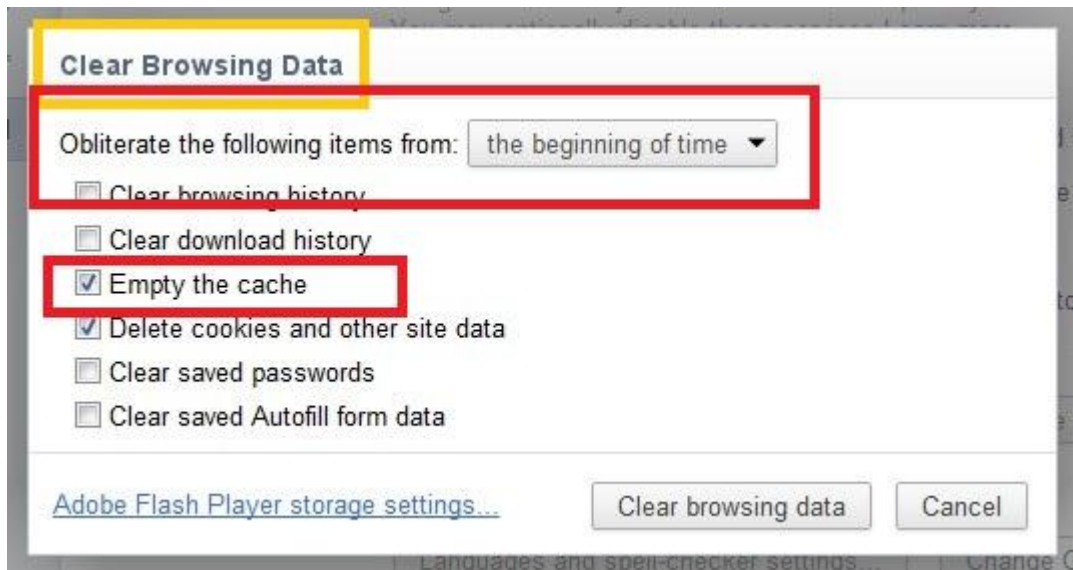
- **Browsing & Download History**

Clear Cache on Google Chrome 10...

Similar to Clear cache on Firefox, you can choose either of following methods:

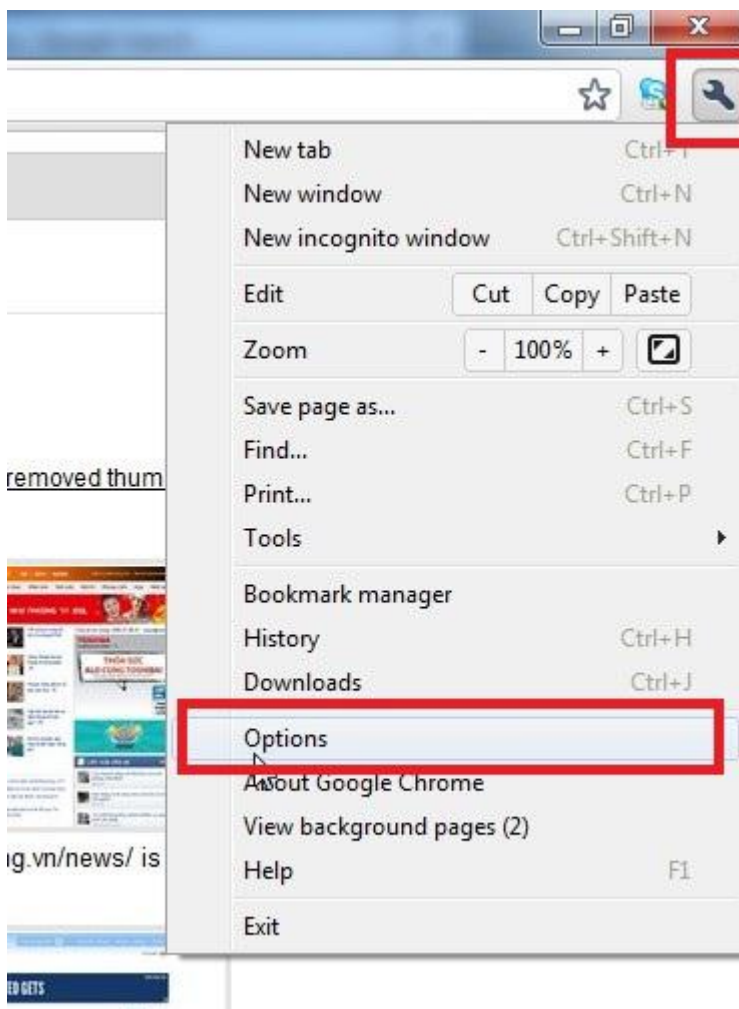
Press the combination buttons: **Ctrl + Shift + Delete** to show the **Clear Browsing Data** box. Make sure the **Empty the cache** is checked then click **Clear browsing data** button. **Note:** you also can change the time range to clear by selecting the drop down list on the top.



Clear Cache Google Chrome

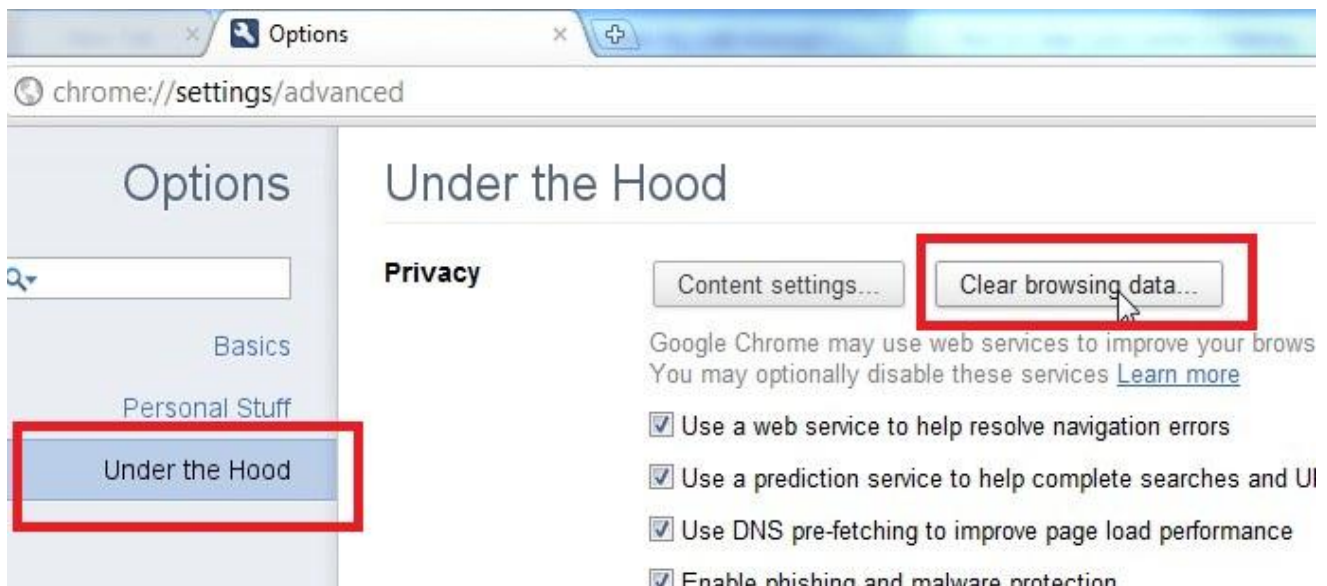
–Or–

1. Click on **an icon** on the top-right and click **Options**



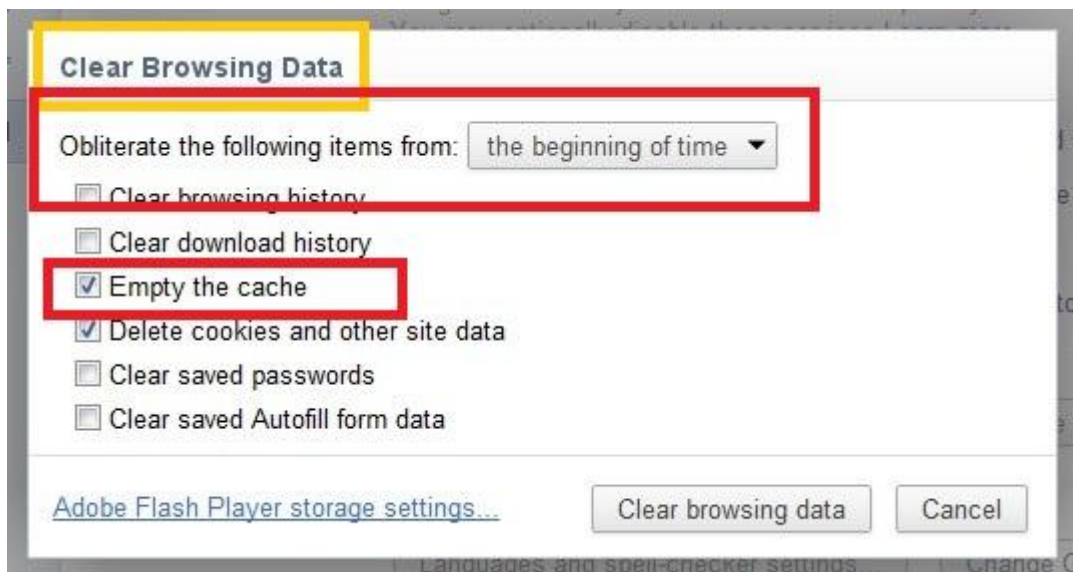
Clear Cache Google Chrome Options

2. Switch to **Under the Hood** section and click on **Clear browsing data...** button

3. Check the **Empty the cache** checkbox then click on **Clear browsing data**, same as previous way.
